Recent events in Israel remind us not to take these freedoms for granted. Yotzim B'sheilah understand all too well what it is to live without them.


2022 saw Hillel continue to support freedom of choice and empowerment for Yotzim B'sheilah by making substantial inroads into new sectors of the Israeli public philanthropy sector, while successfully stewarding our governmental support even in the face of potentially destabilizing political uncertainty.

Our new "Bayit B'kibbutz" project in partnership with Kibbutz Hatzerim is at full capacity providing transitional housing and counselling services to Yotzim in the south, and talks are underway with Kibbutz Be'eri, Kibbutz Sdot Yam and other members of the Kibbutz Movement moving forward.

At the same time, we renewed our government housing agreements, increasing Ministry of Welfare funding through 2027 from NIS 3 million to NIS 6 million annually, allowing us to double housing capacity nationwide and to replicate our Jerusalem Habayit shell Hillel Emergency Shelter facility in Tel Aviv.

Our mission is that every young adult considering leaving Haredi communities anywhere in Israel knows that they can succeed; and that they will be fully supported in the process regardless of external social and political realities.

On behalf of Hillel, and the community of Yotzim B'sheilah in Israel we thank you, our friends and family, for continually working with us towards that shared purpose.




2022 Financials Income Breakdown

Total Income NIS **15,485,212**


Income by sources



Israel NIS 12,885,719




International NIS 2,599,493
